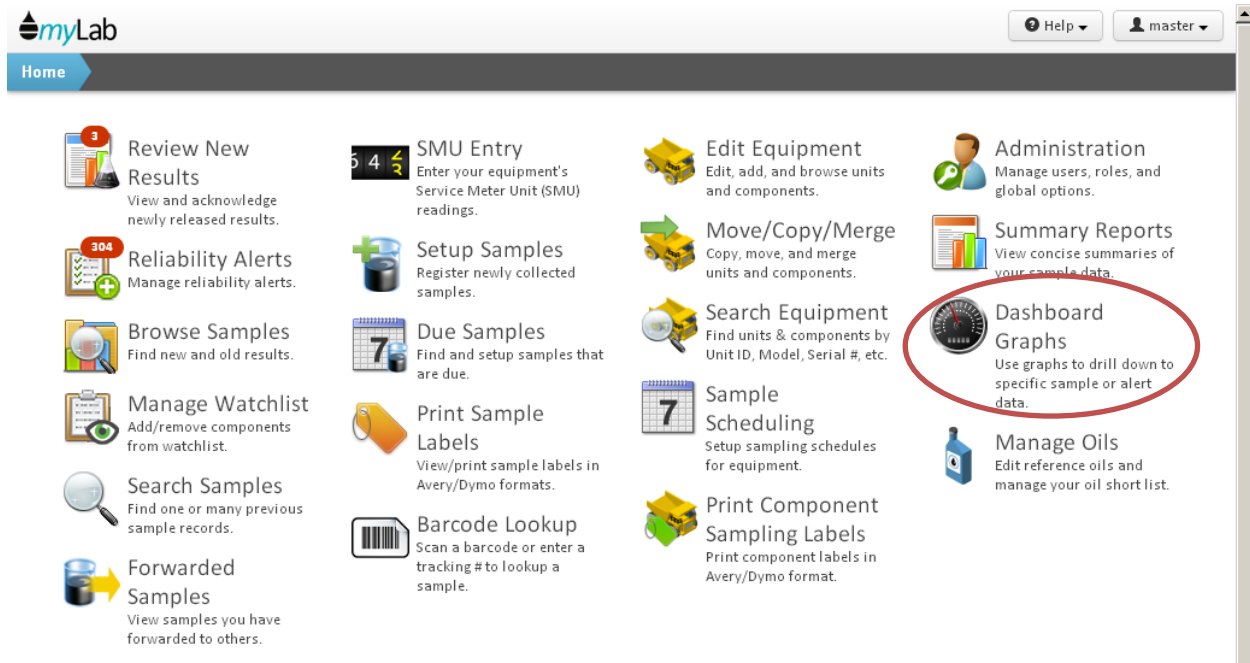
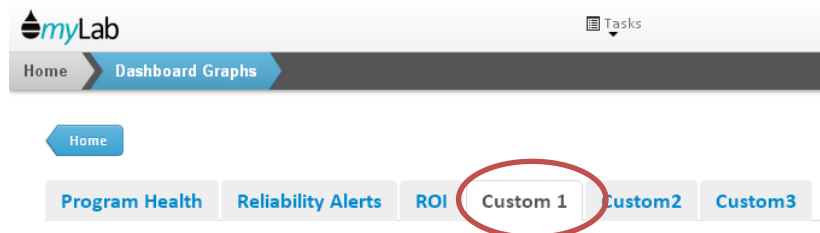


## Customizing the Dashboard

Open the dashboard task.



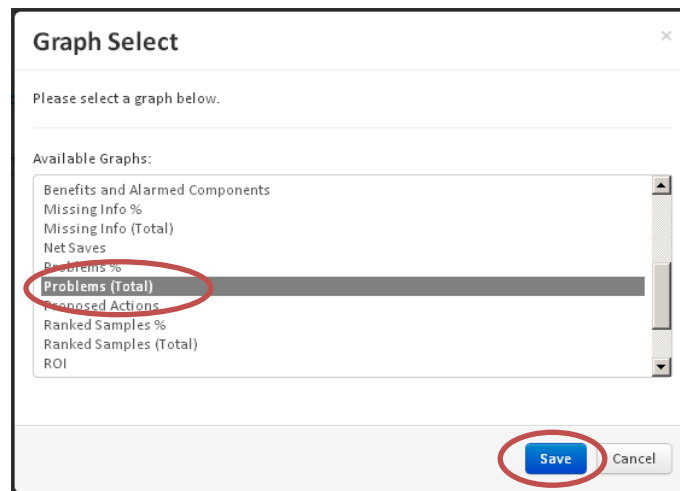
Now, click on the first custom tab, typically called custom 1.



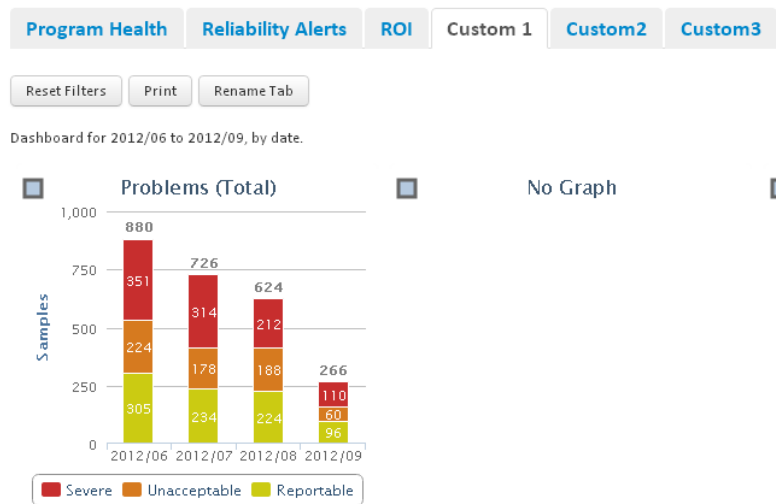
In the custom tabs you can select which graphs you'd like, and in which positions. To select a graph, click here in the upper left of the position.



You get a list of all of the dashboard graphs available. All of the graphs on the first three tabs are available, as well as a few extras. Any graph that was percentage based is available with the total counts. Select the problems total graph and press save.



The graph now appears.



You can now drill into and use these just the same as the normal dashboard graphs.

You can also give my custom tab a new title by clicking here.

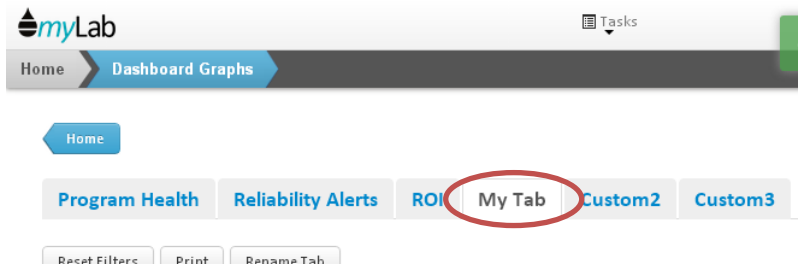


Enter the title, and press save.
